How do I book my child into swim school?

STEP 1: ASSESS

Book a FREE 15 minute assessment to determine the correct level for your child

STEP 2: PROCESS

With the level determined, Customer Service can process your enrolment, payment plan and membership card. Membership cards are scanned to log lesson attendance and enable unlimited pool access (*for direct debit members only*) - so start practicing!

Step 3 - PROGRESS

Throughout the program, students are assessed on an individual basis during ordinary class drills and skill demonstrations. When a student meets the 'must see' criteria, instructors provide them a progress token.

Step 4 - SUCCESS

Students present their progress token at Customer Service in exchange for the Level Award. At this time, Customer Service will assist with the transfer into the new level when a position is available.

How much does it cost?

Direct Debit \$21.50 / fortnight per child joining fee \$14 (if not a current member)

We offer a 12 month direct debit membership for swim school. This means regular fortnightly payments direct from your chosen bank account or credit card. This alleviates the pressure of finding the whole sum at the start of the term.

Paid in Full \$12.40 per lesson per child
paid in full memberships are to be paid in full at the time of enrollment.

We offer a discount of 20% for the third and subsequent child in each family for paid in full memberships.

Important Information

Direct debit memberships entitle the registered student to unlimited pool access throughout the school year and complimentary enrolment into 1 week of holiday intensives per financial year. Direct Debit Memberships are for a minimum period of 12 months and incur a cancellation fee for any cancellations prior to the 12 months.

Program payment is due on enrolment. In the interests of best practice, we do not reserve positions without full payment.

A cooling-off period of seven days commences from the time of enrolment. After such time, all refunds are subject to the discretion of management and absorb a \$25 administration fee.

In recognition of the fact that children develop at different rates, assessment is conducted on an ongoing and individual basis.

Bluewater is a **Watch Around the Water** venue. All children under the age of 10 must be accompanied by a guardian aged 16 years or more at all times. Parents/guardians must be present for the duration of each lesson.
